Endoth's Fang	A curved blade of patinaed metal that comes to a needle-like point, with a decorative hand guard resembling a fanged serpent.	This blade was made to resemble the fangs of the legendary serpent that pierced the veil between the gods and mortals.	Pulling the blade from its sheathe makes an unmistakable hissing sound...
Shadow's Edge Replica	A mirror-like blade capable of reflecting coded candlelight messages meets a pale, carved handle displaying a scene involving a falling star, which represents the origin myth of the royal family.	This replica dagger may convince some that the owner is a member of the highly regarded Queen's Shadow Guard, though close inspection would reveal its flaws.	A real Queen's Shadow Guard dagger's hilt can screw off and hide a small vial of poison, but this one, made of moon ash wood instead of the usual whale bone, has no such ability.
Northern Piercing Plunger	A narrow, pointed spearhead at the end of a hollow wooden shaft fitted with a boar leather grip.	This spear is capable of incredibly hard lunges thanks to the heavy metal rod sliding around inside the spear's hollow shaft, allowing the wielder to pierce most armor and thick-skinned beasts.	Solid doré gold was once used by the Northern clans for the momentum-driving rods inside each spear's hollow shaft, but this one seems to be a stack of copper coins melted together.
The Thirsting One	A massive shield made of jagged, black volcanic stone featuring an unsettling face with curled horns, piercing eyes, and a fanged mouth carved into the stone.	The shield is impossible to lift, but as you stare at it something whispers in your mind, "Bring me the blood of the innocent and my power is yours." The longer you stare the more you feel being drained from you...	Wielding the shield etches your name into the shield's stone forever. You see the familiar names of fallen paladins and disgraced dragonslayers who all believed the shield's power was worth the cost...
Vardonnan Druid's Staff	A staff made of woven golden grass that's been braided into a beautiful pattern. Atop rests a decorative jeweled beetle made of actual jewels.	Carved into the beetle's glistening shell is a prayer that allows the user to momentarily disperse the staff into a cloud of blinding grass before rejoining into its original form.	Many believe Vardonnan druids and their meadows of panacea to be a myth, but this staff's herbaceous scent suggests the grass could be used as an effective medicine in a pinch.
Cyberpunk / Sci-Fi Weapons

Flow's Thrummer-9	A semi-automatic 9mm pistol with a long suppressor fitted with a powerful cylindrical speaker on the barrel, and a wired batter pack attached underneath.	This custom 9mm is fitted with a high-density suppressor and noise canceling thrummer speaker that cancels out the specific sound frequencies the pistol generates when firing, making it nearly silent.	The first attempt to use this noise-cancelling thrummer was a bust, leading to a botched hit and intense chase. It's worked every time since.
BotBlobber X3	A modified air-powered marker gun equipped with a targeting scope, large gas canister, and pellet ammo feeding tube on the side.	Instead of paint pellets, this black-market air gun fires plastic balls filled with programmable nanites that pop and spread on contact. Operators can hotswap between itchBots, brainBots, and metal destroying sunderBots.	Early versions had nanites stuffed into traditional gunpowder bullets for use with traditional firearms, but very few nanites would survive upon impact. Sometimes a low-tech approach is the most effective.
Sick Disk v.19	A metallic, disk-shaped grenade with a magnetic bottom and foil top that's roughly the size of a large coin.	These small throwables emit a cloud of nanites designed to invade nasal passages and induce gagging and vomiting for anyone whose DNA has not been flagged on the preprogrammed safe list. Nanites disable in minutes.	Early test subjects went through several rounds of EMP nanite-removal therapy to stop the symptoms, but were unable to regain appetite and subsequently starved to death.
Snake Eye	An extendable, maneuverable 4mm wide carbon fiber tube fitted with hundreds of articulation points, and a multifunctional camera lens at the end.	This replacement mod turns a finger into an extending snake cam with 10x digital zoom, night vision, and infrared, capable of sliding under doors or through window cracks, allowing the user to easily see beyond barriers via their brain-connected OS.	Originally meant for combat surgeons in active war zones, these mods are now used by thieves and hitmen. The snake cam doesn't allow replaced fingers to bend at the first knuckle, so it's easy to spot users due to "hook finger."
